Arriving at Unalaska, thou didst render thanks to the Lord for thy safe passage. Kneeling on the beach together with all those in thy company, thou didst praise God with the hymn: Alleluia!

Together with thy tutor, the Aleut chieftain Ivan, thou didst study the Native language and devised a writing system for it. Thou didst labor for many years, preparing the Word of God for publication in the Aleut tongue. Thou didst astound the indigenous peoples with thine ability to preach to them in their own language, thus enlightening them with the Light of Christian Truth. We glorify God for bringing thee to our shores and honor thine evangelical accomplishments:

Kontakion 5

Thou didst travel throughout the Aleutian region, braving storms and hostile seas in thine efforts to evangelize thy scattered flock. Warmed by thy love for the Lord, thou didst journey in thy bidarka on the icy waves, softly singing to the Creator of all: Alleluia!

Ikos 5

During the ten years thou hadst remained in the Aleutian Islands, thou didst devote much time and energy to the study of the land, people, and wildlife of the area. Thou didst keep careful records of thine experiences and observations so that this heritage could be preserved for future generations. Thou didst open schools for the Native children so that they could advance in the knowledge of God and His Creation.

Having created a written language for the Native people, thou didst develop textbooks for them so that they could become literate. Reading the Word of God in their own tongue, and giving thanks to God, the Aleuts sang with joy: Alleluia!

O Holy Father, thou didst travel beyond the limits of thine own extensive district into

the land of the Eskimo people. Thou didst bring to the natives of Bristol Bay the sanctifying Grace of Holy Baptism. Thou madest the Nushagak River a new Jordan for them, bringing Christianity to the northern shores of the Bering Sea, where thou art remembered today with these words of praise:

Rejoice! Enlightener of the Eskimo Nation!

Rejoice! Sanctification of the Nushagak!

Rejoice! Husbandman sent to the plentiful harvest!

Rejoice! Laborer in the Vineyard of Christ!

Rejoice! Warrior clothed in the armor of Truth!

Rejoice! Soldier armed with the Gospel of Peace and the sword of Prayer!

Rejoice! O Holy Father Innocent, Equal to the Apostles and Enlightener of Alaska!

Kontakion 7

Using thy talents, thou didst erect the first Orthodox Cathedral in the New World, designing the Temple and supervising its construction thyself. The faithful celebrated the consecration of the new church, singing the hymn of Thanksgiving: Alleluia!

Ikos 7

Transferring the center of thy missionary activity to the city of New Archangel, thou didst begin anew the evangelization of the Tlingit People. Thou becamest proficient in their language and preached the Gospel in their villages winning converts to Christ by thy knowledge of medicine as well as theology. Thou didst admire the nobility of these proud warriors, who together with us offer these praises to thee:

Rejoice! Teacher of the Tlingit Indians!

Rejoice! Physician of souls and bodies!

Rejoice! Fearless apostle, protected by God!

Rejoice! Illuminator of the Northern Peoples!

Rejoice! Mountain rising above the clouds of error!

Kontakion 8

Thou wast summoned to appear before the Holy Synod to present thy many translations for ecclesiastical approval. Thou didst return to thy homeland by circumnavigating the globe; arriving at St. Petersburg thou didst praise God in song: Alleluia!

Ikos 8

Learning of the repose of thy wife, Katherine, during thine absence, thou didst prayerfully visit the Holy monasteries at Kiev and Sergiyev Posad in order to discern the Lord's Will. The Emperor himself, impressed with thine apostolic fervor and achievements, approved thy elevation to the rank of bishop. Returning to Alaska, thou wwast welcomed with these words:

Rejoice! Thou didst take up the Cross and follow Christ!

Rejoice! Thou didst first bring the Joy of the Resurrection to Alaska!

Rejoice! Thou wast inspired by the heroic example of St. Innocent of Irkutsk!

Rejoice! Thou didst promote the apostolic labors of St. Nicholas of Japan!

Rejoice! Thou wast among the first to ask the Elder Herman to intercede for thee!

Rejoice! By his prayers thou didst arrive safely in Kodiak!

Rejoice! O Holy Father Innocent, Equal to the Apostles and Enlightener of Alaska!

Kontakion 9

As bishop of the Russian colony, thou didst renew thine efforts to bring the Gospel to all Alaska. Thou didst open a seminary in Sitka for the training of indigenous clergy anddesigned a new cathedral for the capital city. Thou also didst construct the clock for the church bell tower. When the Holy Temple was completed, thou didst song out in gratitude to the Lord: Alleluia!

Ikos 9

As overseer of the huge diocese which included Eastern Siberia as well as Alaska, thou didst dispatch priests to areas where no missionaries had ever gone. Thine own son-in-law was assigned to the Nushagak, while thy former student, Father Jacob, set out for the Yukon delta. Because of thy great vision for the future of Orthodoxy in this land, we honor thee with these hymns:

Transferring thy headquarters to the Far East, thou didst bid farewell to the New World and returned to the Old. Following the example thou hadst set for them, the Native clergy of Alaska continued thy work in America. Through them we have become thy spiritual children and venerate thy memory in these words:

Rejoice! Preacher 'in tongues' like the Apostles on Pentecost!

Rejoice! Thou didst publish the Gospel in the Aleut language!

Rejoice! Thou didst direct the evangelization of Alaska and Siberia!

Rejoice! Thou didst plant the seeds of the Orthodox Faith on American soil!

Rejoice! O Holy Father Innocent, Equal to the Apostles and Enlightener of Alaska!

Thou didst spend thine entire life laboring in remote regions for the propagation of the Holy Faith. In thy later years thou wast called to yet another great task. Thou wast elected Metropolitan of Moscow to succeed the venerable Philaret. Troparion, St Innocent - Tone 4

Another Troparion, St Innocent - Tone 2
